



Notification

On the November 2, 2010 election ballot there will be a referendum question as follows:

“Shall a Government Study Commission of seven members be elected to study the issue of consolidation or merger of the Borough of Slippery Rock and the Township of Slippery Rock, Butler County, Pennsylvania; to provide a recommendation on consolidation or merger; to consider the advisability of the adoption of a new home rule charter; and to draft a new home rule charter, if recommended in the report of the commission?”

This commission will consist of both Slippery Rock Borough residents and Slippery Rock Township residents. The seven people with the most votes, whether borough residents or township residents, will be on this commission. So therefore, Slippery Rock Township needs registered voters to run for this seven (7) board commission.

If you are interested in running for this commission. You will need to go the Butler County Courthouse, Bureau of Elections on/or before Tuesday, August 3, 2010 and get a petition. This petition has to be filed at the Butler County Court House, Bureau of Election on/or before Tuesday, August 24, 2010. You will need to get approximately forty (40) signatures of township residents from either party for this petition.
